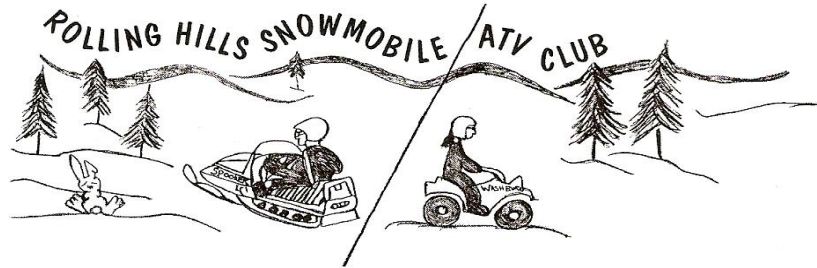

TRAIL REPORT:

As a result of the unexpected early snowfall everyone is anxious to get out and ride, but please control the urge. We have several deer seasons in the near future and the earliest trails could be opened will be **December 11th**.

There will not be any grooming done until on or near that date.

Please remember that some of the trail miles are on private land so respect the landowner's rights and do not travel the trails until they are officially opened. A violation in this regard could very well cost us the loss of a portion of the trail.

EQUIPMENT REPORT:

The new drag is good to go once the tool box gets mounted. There was a recall on the other drag. A reinforcement piece needs to be installed in the front to address some weak welds. That should take a couple hours work and it will also be good to go. Maintenance on the tractor is a priority. Brusher repairs will not be completed until next year.
