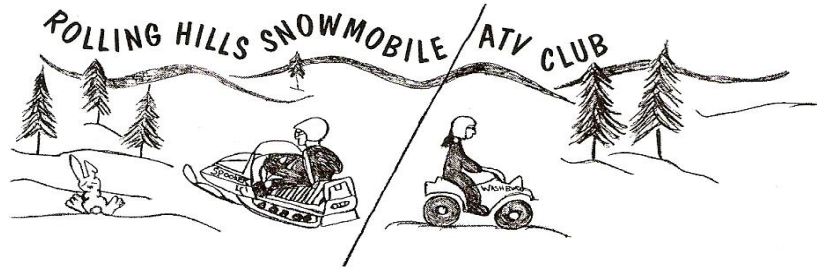

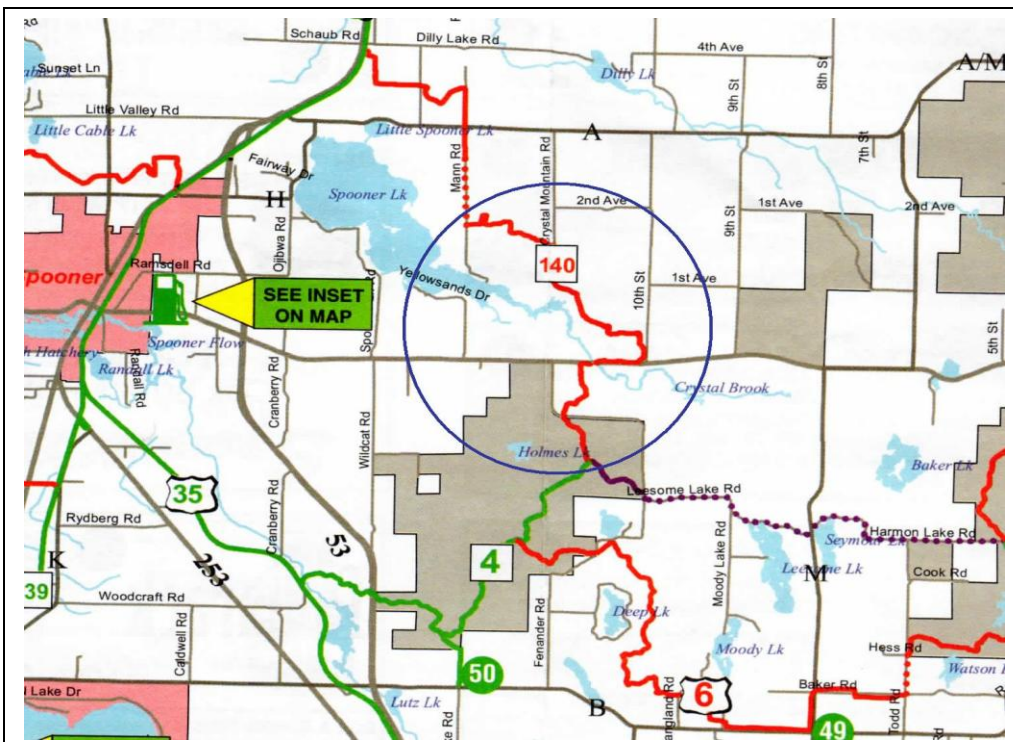
## WE NEED YOUR HELP!
