Great News! We have scheduled our Annual Snowmobile trip assuming snow conditions permit. A block of 13 rooms have been reserved in the name of Rolling Hills at the **Great Northern Motel, 5070 N Highway 51, Mercer, WI 54547 (715.476.2440)**. The rooms are reserved for check in on 2/15/2022 and check out on 2/20/2022 if you wish to stay through the weekend. You must book your room 45 days before February 15. The rooms will be released to the public after that. When making the reservation there will be a \$25 deposit which will be applied to your bill upon check out. The deposit is non-refundable if the reservation is canceled. The rooms are on the second floor, 2 queen size beds and \$129/night plus tax. The Club's policy is to pay for two nights if you are an officer, or a Board member, or if you have worked on trail maintenance, grading, grooming, or the like for 40 or more hours in the last 12 month period.
