## WATVA NEWS

WATVA (Wisconsing ATV/UTV Association) NW Regional coordinator Greg Olson was a guest speaker at the April meeting. Among other things, he announced that Rolling Hills Snowmobile and ATV Club will be hosting the NW Regional Meeting this year. It will be held at the Railroad Park Pavillion on Saturday August 24. One of the main topics of the 2024 WATVA Annual Meeting, attended by our WATVA rep, was the results of the 2023 Economic & Demographic Report commissioned by WATVA. This report aims to understand the relative and overall economic significance that ATV/UTV recreation provides to the State of Wisconsin.

Wisconsin traditionally scores at the top of the gross domestic product (GDP) results as

provided by the US Bureau of Economic Analysis(BEA) related to motorcycling/ATV/UTVing. Our statewide study is much more specific as it measured positive economic impacts that apply for summer ATV/UTV trail riding, winter trail riding, road route riding and the multi day longer trips that some call overlanding. This EIS (Economic Impact Study) resulted in a "Total Economic Effect" of an astonishingly robust \$5.4 billion.
